

Improvement Plans/ Performance Reporting:

Issue:

Performance monitoring is often a management requisite to gauge how well the organisations management systems are functioning. It has also become common place in public environmental reports.

Monitoring and measuring the status of environmental programs and Key Performance Indicators (KPI) is essential to evidence improvement. Additionally, indicators including energy (electricity and gas), waste and water consumption may identify room for improvement and cost savings.
